Policy for Fabrics in shades/prints/types not stocked by us as Standard Stock and the supply of CMT Fabrics for CMT Orders.

Dear Customer,

Policy-Custom Fabric & Colour Orders – Minimum Fabric Commitment (MFC)

For any garment style requested in a **fabric** not stocked as standard by us or a **shade/print** of fabric not stocked by us as standard, we will require orders to be sufficient to utilise, or financially cover, a minimum of **10 metres of fabric**. 10 Meters being the MFC for a Fabric Type/Shade/Print that is not our standard stock.

This requirement is necessary due to the costs associated with bespoke fabric orders, including surplus fabric that often remains in stock for extended periods, together with the additional purchasing, delivery and administrative costs involved which on occasions having left us with losses against small orders. Our Stock fabrics turn over regularly and fast enough for this not to be an issue.

The MOQ – Minimum Order Quantity will increase if the fabrics are not our standard stock. To confirm our MOQ of 18 per style, shade and type remains when it is produced from our standard stock.

Policy for CMT Fabrics

CMT Fabrics will only be accepted for orders where the patterns and any associated haberdashery, labels, and packaging have been supplied by the Customer, i.e. on a true CMT basis. Fabrics cannot be supplied on a CMT basis for styles developed for production by The Sewing Factory Ltd. unless otherwise agreed.

This requirement is necessary due to losses in the production costs and profit margins from small to medium sized orders. This ensures there is no circumnavigation of the true cost of our own in-house produced styles and grading.
